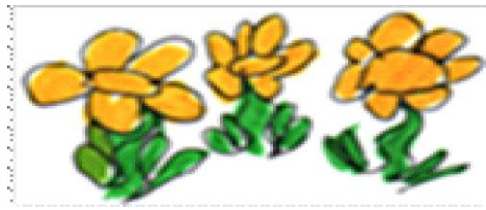

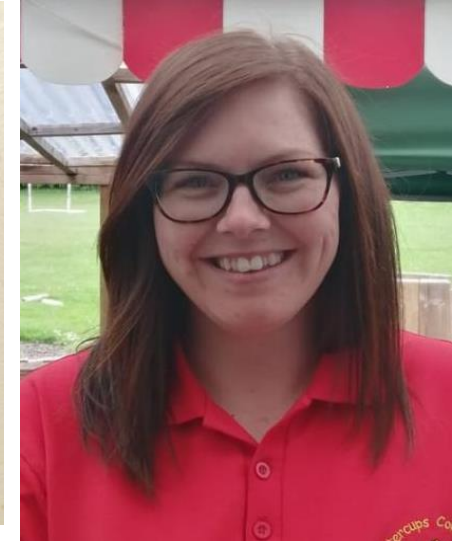

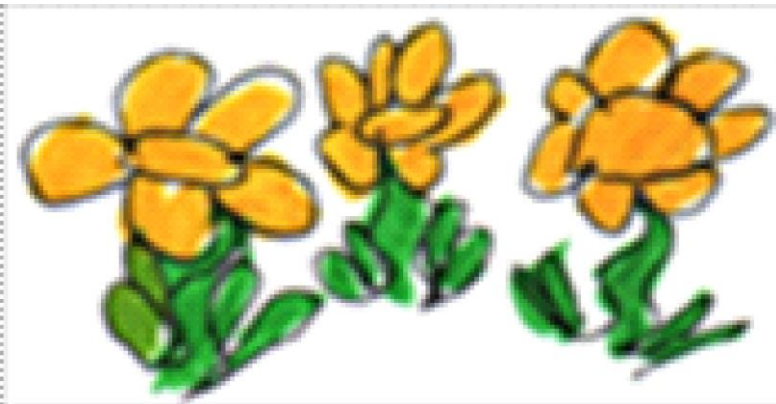

A lunch box if you are staying for lunch.

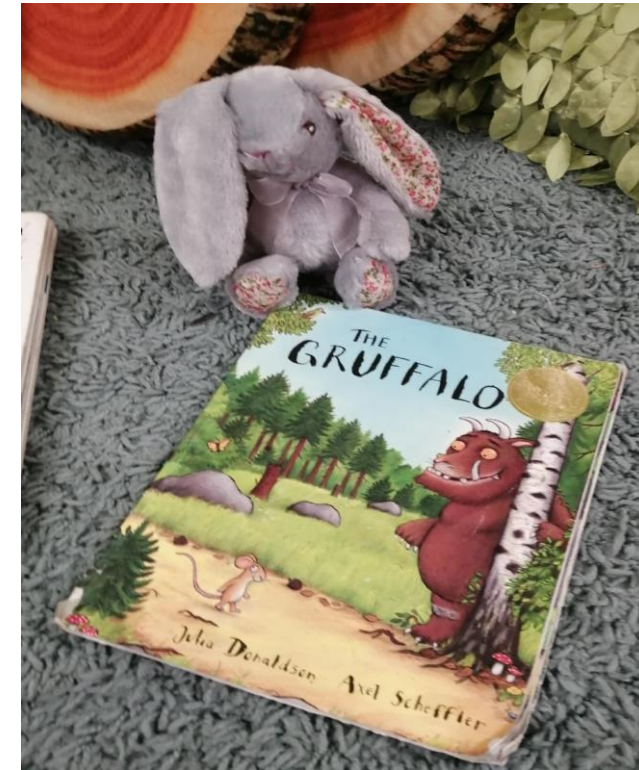
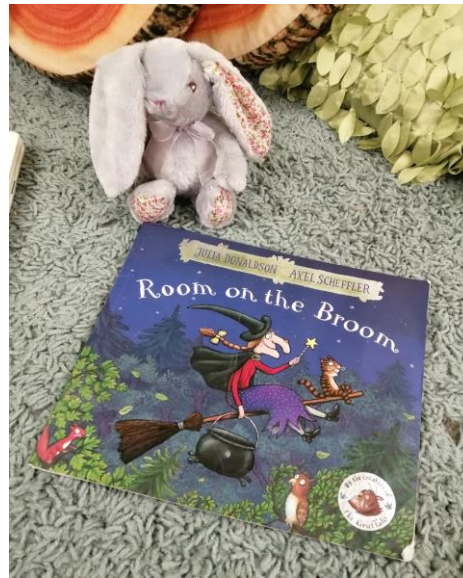
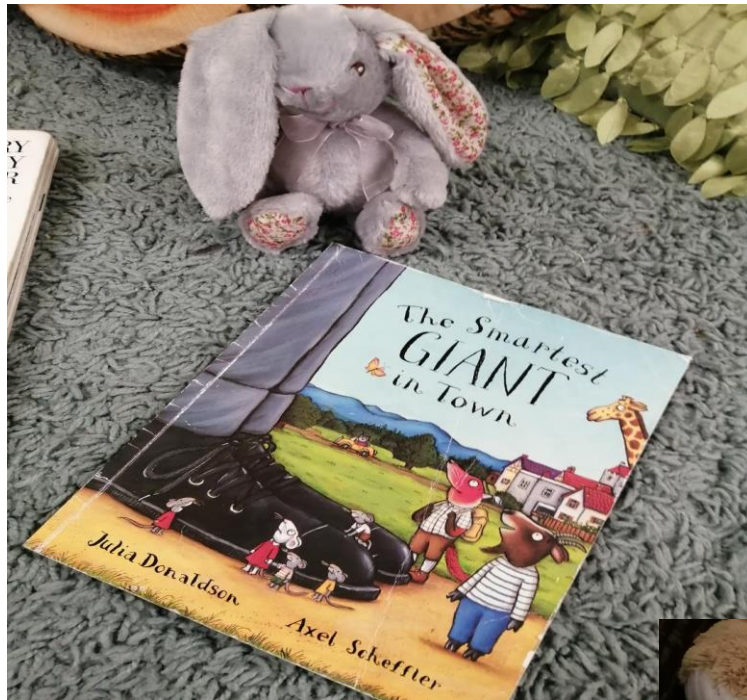


A coat and wellies for rainy days as we like to go out and splash in puddles.
